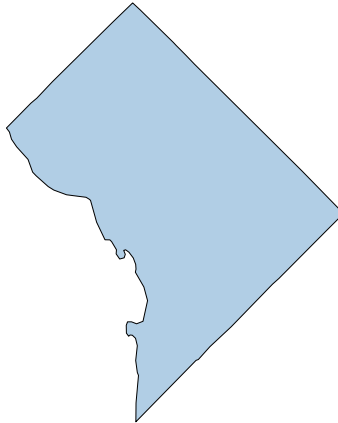

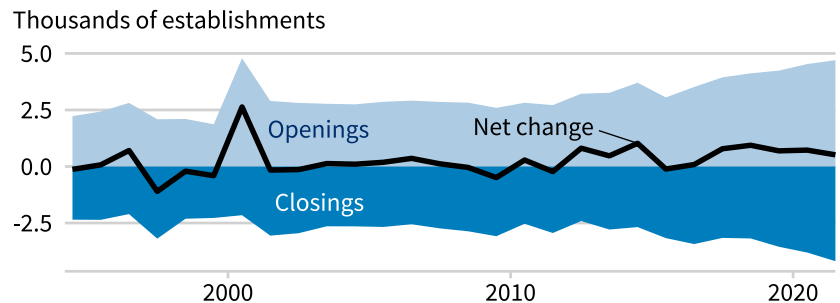

Business dynamics

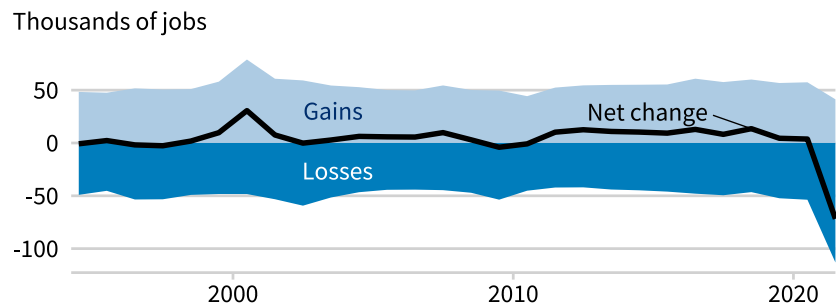
Establishments

Between March 2020 and March 2021, 4,703 DC establishments opened and 4,186 closed, for a net increase of 517. Employment expanded at 5,353 establishments and contracted at 8,573. Small businesses accounted for 4,295 establishment openings and 3,737 closings.



Employment

Opening and expanding DC establishments added 41,316 jobs, while closing and contracting establishments lost 113,102, for a net decrease of 71,786 jobs. Small businesses gained 30,928 jobs and lost 73,455, for a net decrease of 42,527 jobs.

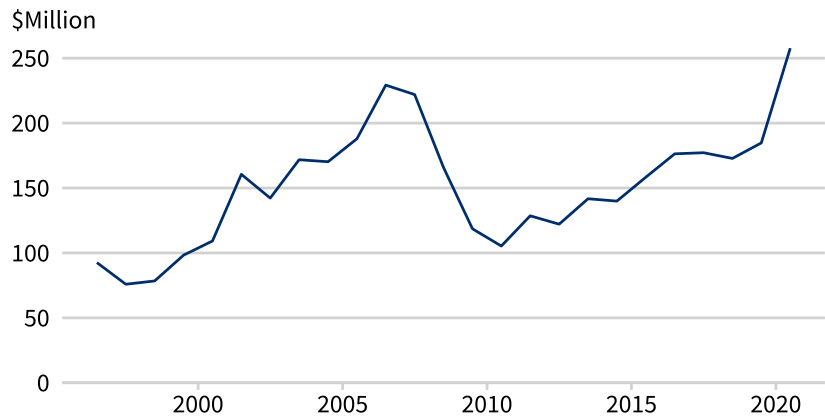

Small business loans





The Community Reinvestment Act requires large banks to report new small business loans. In 2020, reporting banks issued \$257.7 million in loans to DC businesses with revenues of \$1 million or less. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$100,000 or less was \$328.0 million. Total reported new lending to businesses through loans of \$1 million or less was \$1.2 billion.

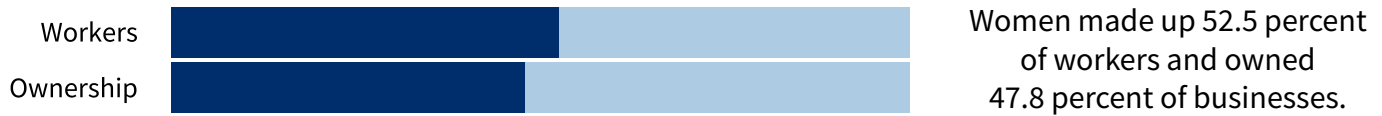
Small business exports

A total of 517 identified firms exported goods worth \$900.0 million from the District in 2020. Of those exporters, 390—or 75.4 percent—were small. Exports by small firms reached \$873.0 million, making up 97.0 percent of exports by identified firms.

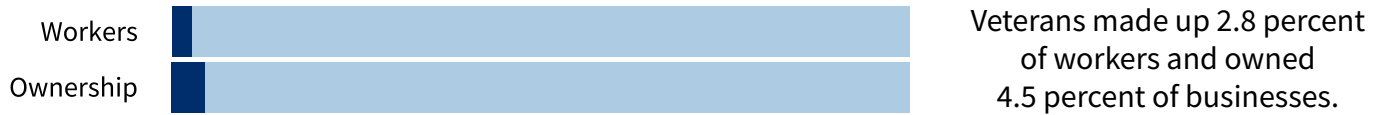

Business ownership share by demographic group

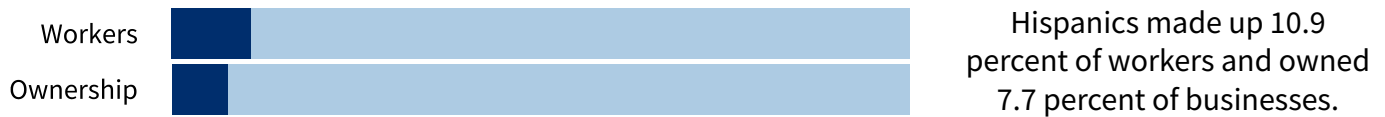

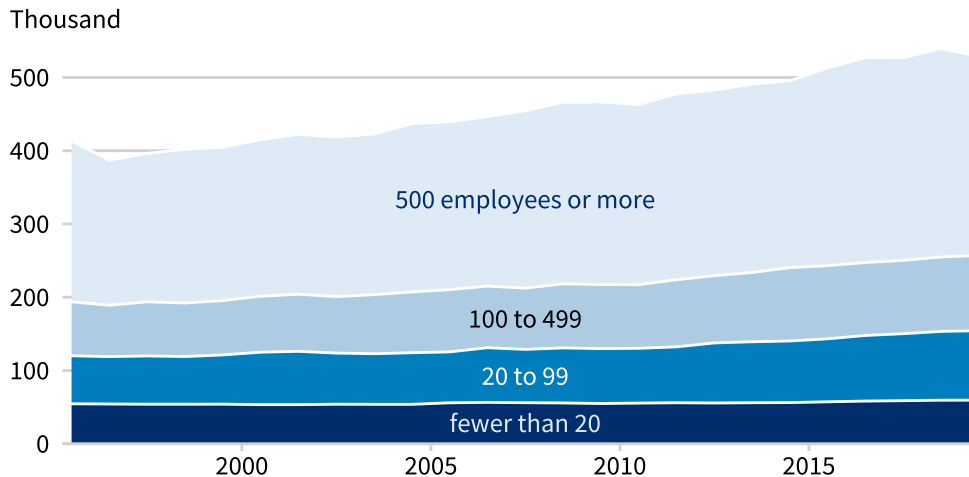
